Key of G! - Monday, September 11, 2023 - 7:00 PM

AJ Bisto’s first gig was at age 5 when he sang at his cousin’s wedding. By age 8, he was filling in on lead vocals for the house band at the local American Legion and continued singing through his high school years for several bands and landed numerous lead roles in school musicals. The inspiration for *Key of G Live!* developed after AJ was recruited by a cruise line to perform as Garth for one of their variety shows. Due to AJ’s natural vocal having an uncanny resemblance to the sound of Garth Brooks he has been encouraged by numerous industry professionals to create a tribute show to the #1 solo selling artist of all time.

Vox Fortura - Thursday, October 5, 2023 - 7:00 PM

Vox Fortura is the newest Classical Crossover group from the United Kingdom. As recent Semi-Finalists of *Britain’s Got Talent* this show-stopping group is bringing clasical vocals back into the mainstream. Filled with personality and style, their ability to perform almost any era or genre of music is their iconic crossover style that touches on everything from Elgar and Bizet’s “Pearl Fishers” to David Bowie, John Legend and Ed Sheeran. The Jason Fabus Trio is a jazz group led by saxophonist Jason Fabus. They are a staple in the budding Jazz & Swing Dancing scene in Los Angeles. The group focuses on tight and swinging arrangements of songs from the Golden Era of American music. Many of their jazz standards are from the 1920-50’s. Even their original music will give the listener that same familiar sound. They evoke the stylings of the Nat “King” Cole Trio, and Fabus has often been likened to the sound of Paul Desmond.

Greg Ransom began playing the piano at 10 years old. Thanks to a piano instructor with a slant toward Rock, Greg’s interest in playing piano ran through high school learning Theory, Harmony I and II, Stage band, and Madrigal singers. At age 21, Greg was playing piano in a downtown hotel bar when the owner of the hotel requested an Elton John song. Greg played “I Guess That’s Why They Call It The Blues.” The hotel owner approached him afterwards and told him he sounded like Elton vocally, and that he should consider putting on the hat and glasses and forming a tribute band. By 1995, Bennie and the Jets were formed. They have performed around the world for a wide variety of venues.

Sounds of Silence Tribute - Thursday, April 11, 2024 - 7:00 PM

Performed by Steven Delopoulos and Johnny Phillips of the award-winning band *Burlap to Cashmere*, The Sounds of Silence Tribute is a throwback to the early 70’s Greenwich Village folk scene.
